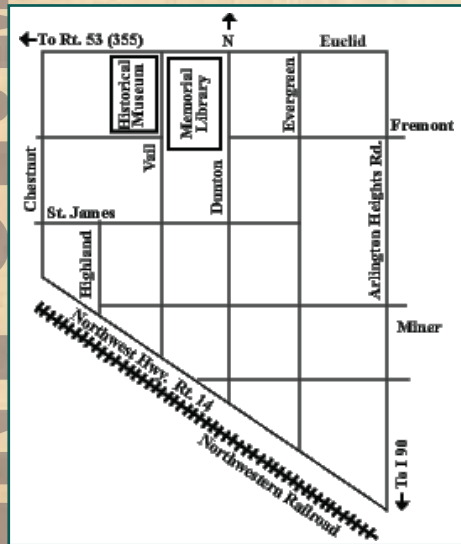

STORY GARDEN WALK



A familiar story unfolds during a walk around the museum grounds as students develop their senses in search of signs of spring. **Note: offered in spring only.**

A visit to our Log House and a mixture of old fashioned chores and pastimes help students experience what life was like for the first pioneers in our area.

HARVEST HOME



Through a variety of activities, students learn about the “first” Thanksgiving and what harvest time was like for the settlers and farmers of early Arlington Heights. **Note: offered in fall only.**

HISTORIC HOUSE TOUR



Students will visit our 1882 F. W. Müller House, the 1908 N. M. Banta House, the Coach House and the replica 1830s Log House. There are hands-on activities along the way.

Grades: All **Class length:** 2 hrs

MOVIN' WEST



Why did settlers come to Illinois and how did they get here? Students find out when they visit our historic houses, barter in the general store and help “load the wagon”.

Grades: 2-3 **Class length:** 2 hrs

HOMESTEADIN' DAYS



Discover what daily life was like for the early settlers of Arlington Heights. Students will perform chores, attend school and enjoy some childrens' pastimes of long ago.

DIGGING FOR HISTORY



What might an archaeology dig be like at the Arlington Heights Historical Museum? Students will sift for artifacts, analyze old photographs and search for other clues about the Müller family and their soda pop business.

Students visit the footprint of the town of Dunton in downtown Arlington Heights, learn its history and explore the rich, architectural variety found in the surrounding neighborhood.
